## Format

Triple Round Robin: 6 rounds of 12 board matches; with IMPs being converted to VPs using the continuous 20 VP scale for 12-board matches.

## Seating

The team that is to SEAT must be seated 5 minutes before the start of the round. The team that is to CHOOSE then seats.

\* Seating arrangements for the last 3 rounds will be advised.

## Time per Round

The allotted time for each match shall be 78 minutes to get the last board into play and the results for the last board must be entered within 85 minutes.
